**CASTING A VOTE:** To vote for the candidate of your choice, darken the oval ( ● ) at the LEFT of the candidate's name. If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the Election Official and obtain another. Do not attempt to change any marks made in error.  
**WRITE-IN:** A write-in vote will NOT be counted unless the vote is for a DECLARED write-in candidate. To vote for a write-in candidate, darken the oval to the LEFT of the name you have written in or your vote will not be counted.

If you do not wish to vote a straight party ticket, do not make a mark in this section, and proceed to voting the ballot by office.</p> <p>(2) To vote a straight party ticket for the party of your choice for all candidates on this ballot, except for candidates described in (3) below, darken the oval to the left of the party name and do not make any other marks on this ballot.</p> <p>(3) To vote for any candidate for an at-large office to which more than one (1) person may be elected, you must darken the oval for each candidate you wish to vote for. A straight party vote will not count as a vote for any candidate for that office.</p> <p>(4) If you wish to vote for a candidate seeking a nonpartisan office or on a public question, you must darken the oval on the appropriate place on this ballot.</p>	<p><b>PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES</b> Vote for one (1) only</p> <p>A ballot cast for the named candidates for President and Vice President of the United States is considered a ballot cast for the slate of presidential electors and alternate presidential electors nominated by that political party or independent candidate.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> DONALD J.
