ORDINANCE NO. 19 -2020

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
THE INFORMAL ADJUSTMENT PROGRAM FEE FUND

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Juvenile Probation Department collects Informal Adjustment Program Fees for certain juvenile delinquency matters, and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 33-37-8-5 requires that Informal Adjustment Program Fees must be deposited into a county user fee fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to establish the "Informal Adjustment Program Fee Fund" for the above-stated purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. **Establishment:** The Informal Adjustment Program Fee Fund (the "Fund"), which is assigned **Fund Number 2520**, is hereby established as a non-reverting county user fee fund to be administered and maintained by the Clark County Auditor.
2. **Deposits into the Fund:** Only monies from the said Program shall be deposited into the Fund.
3. **Purposes of Permitted Expenditures from the Fund:** Money in the Fund shall be used only to pay those expenses allowed under the said Program.
4. **Term of Fund:** The term of existence of the Fund shall be perpetual until the Fund is fully expended or terminated by subsequent ordinance adopted by this Board.
5. **Auditor's Duty to Manage the Fund:** The Clark County Auditor is hereby directed to maintain and manage accurate accounting information regarding the receipts, expenditures, and balances of the Fund as well as any reporting requirements pursuant to Indiana law.

6. **Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.


