

ORDINANCE NO. 12 - 2011

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING ARTICLE 6,
SECTION 6-3, OF ORDINANCE
NO. 7-1983 (THE CLARK COUNTY
TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDINANCE)
IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH AUTHORITY
FOR THE INSTALLATION AND ENFORCEMENT
OF STOP SIGNS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS.**

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board of Commissioners"), is the county executive body pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is further the county legislative body pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has previously passed and adopted Ordinance No. 7-1983 entitled *The Clark County Traffic Control Ordinance*, which ordinance has since been amended from time-to-time; and,

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Clark County Engineer, the Board now finds it to be appropriate and necessary to again amend *The Clark County Traffic Control Ordinance* in order to establish authority for the installation and enforcement of stop signs at the intersections of public streets in the unincorporated territory of Clark County that are more fully described in this Ordinance, and the Board now adopts this Ordinance for such purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. Article 6, Section 6-3, of Ordinance No. 7-1983 is hereby amended to establish authority for the installation and enforcement of a ^{3-way} stop light ~~at~~ ^{stop sign} at the following intersection:

a. Charlestown-Memphis Road and Stricker Road, located in Clark County, Indiana.

2. All other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 7-1983, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its adoption by this Board of Commissioners.
