ORDINANCE NO. 19 -2013

**AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING THE AUTHORIZATION FOR FUND NUMBER 4934 –
“911 LOIT”**

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Home Rule provisions of IC 36-1-3, *et seq.*, this Board has the authority to exercise all the powers needed for the effective operation of government as to local affairs, subject only to the limitations contained within statutes; and,

WHEREAS, sometime in the year of 2010, this Board created Fund Number 4934 titled “911 LOIT” to augment the county’s 911 shortfall; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has identified the need to ratify and/or authorize the establishment of a fund for county and municipal 911 LOIT monies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. The establishment of Fund Number 4934 – “911 LOIT” (non-reverting).
2. The monies shall be expended for, but not limited to: operating expenses; personnel salaries; benefits; building maintenance; equipment; training expenses; travel; and professional services for county 911.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
