## AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE SPEED LIMIT FOR A CERTAIN SECTION OF COUNTY ROAD 403

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 9-21-1-3, and I.C. 9-21-5 et. Seq., a local authority, with respect to private roads and highways under the authority's jurisdiction may alter the prima facie speed limits of those roads; and

WHEREAS, Commerce Park Drive is under this Board's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, this Board, upon the recommendation from the Clark County Sheriff's and County Highway Departments, desires to lower the speed limit for a certain section of County Road 403.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

- 1. The speed limit for that portion of County Road 403 at the intersection of Lincoln Blvd. through to Greenleaf Drive, shall be lowered from Forty-Five (45) miles per hour to thirty (30) miles per hour during school hours.
- 2. The county engineer is hereby ordered to post the necessary signs in accordance with Indiana law and INDOT specifications notifying drivers of such change.

- 3. The speed limit reduction shall become effective when the signs giving notice of the local speed reduction have been posted.
- 4. The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
