ORDINANCE NO. 5-2014

**AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING DISTRIBUTION OF MONIES
TO VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS FROM TIMBER SALES**

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, in the year 2013, the Department of Natural Resources, through the State Forestry Sale of Timber from Clark County, allocated thirty two thousand one hundred sixty-nine dollars and twenty-eight cents (\$32,169.28) to Clark County; and,

WHEREAS, each volunteer fire department is limited to receiving a maximum annual distribution of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) without additional legislative approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. Volunteer fire departments are a vital part of Clark County, Indiana and its safety.
2. Each volunteer fire department having a cooperative lease agreement or contract with the division of forestry shall be given one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to assist their department.
3. The remainder of the monies will be deposited in the general fund pursuant to statute.

4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
