CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

August 11, 2016

The Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana met in Regular Session on August 11, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. in Room 404, Clark County Government Building, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

Present at the meeting were Commissioners – Jack Coffman, Rick Stephenson, and Bryan Glover is absent, County Attorney Lisa Glickfield, Deputy Auditor Jill Evans, and Auditor Monty Snelling.

Approval of the Minutes

Commissioner Stephenson motioned to approve the July 28, 2016, Regular Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion approved 2-0. Note that Commissioner Glover is absent.
