ORDINANCE NO. 34 -2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 6, SECTION 6-2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 7-1983 (THE CLARK COUNTY TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDINANCE) IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH AUTHORITY FOR THE INSTALLATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF STOP SIGNS AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Board has previously passed and adopted Ordinance 7-1983 entitled “The Clark County Traffic Control Ordinance, which said Ordinance has been amended from time-to-time; and,

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Clark County Engineer, the Board now finds it to be appropriate and necessary to again amend The Clark County Traffic Control Ordinance in order to establish authority for the installation and enforcement of stop signs at the intersections of public streets in the unincorporated territory of Clark County that are more fully described in this Ordinance, and the Board adopts this Ordinance for such purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Article 6, Section 6-2 of Ordinance NO. 7-1983 is hereby amended to establish authority for the installation and enforcement of stop signs and the creation of a multi-stop intersection at the following intersections located in Clark County, Indiana:
 - a. **Three-Way Stop at Eagle Trail and Falcon Road (with two stop signs at Eagle Trail and one stop sign at Falcon Road).**
 - b. **Three Way Stop at Falcon Road and Eagle Trail (with two stops at Falcon Road and one stop sign at Eagle Trail).**
2. All other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 7-1983, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

3. That this Ordinance shall be effective upon final passage and approval by the Board of Commissioners.




