ORDINANCE NO. 24 -2021

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE ARP CORONAVIRUS  
LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND (ORDINANCE NO. 7-2021)

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the Board ordained Ordinance No. 7-2021 (an Ordinance Establishing the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund) for the purpose of receipting, holding and expending allowable federal assistance program receipts and expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board now desires to Amend said Ordinance for the purpose of establishing an initial Plan and Priorities for the use of said funds pursuant to the requirements of both Federal law and Indiana law.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, THAT THE INTITIAL PLAN AND INITIAL PRIORITIES FOR THE USE OF THE ARP LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS SHALL BE THE FOLLOWING:**

1. Providing Premium Pay to employees of Clark County Government for the performance of essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency.
2. For the provision of County government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue of the County due to the COVID-19 public health emergency.
3. For allowable infrastructure projects located in the unincorporated territory of Clark County that are ‘shovel-ready’ and that have the greatest benefit and impact on public health, safety and welfare,
4. For sharing in the costs of a Sewer Service Feasibility Study for the Starlight geographic area.
5. The Funds must be appropriated by the County Fiscal Body (the County Council) before use in accordance with Federal and State law, the Ordinance, and the Plan. All disbursements

must go through the normal claims process as set forth in I.C. 5-11-10-1.6 and be supported with sufficient documentation. All disbursements must be made directly from the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund. Money in the Fund may not be transferred to another Fund of the unit.

6. That this Initial Plan and Priorities will be supplemented and amended as needed with additional details and additional uses as determined by the Board.


7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of the Board.
