ORDINANCE NO. 16 -2017

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE PAYROLL DEDUCTION FOR THE
EMPLOYEE PORTION OF MONTHLY HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, currently the County deducts the entire County employee portion of the monthly health insurance premium from a single paycheck each month instead of dividing the health insurance premium deduction equally each pay period throughout the year.

WHEREAS, the current method of the employee health insurance premium deduction creates a burden for the County employees.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to relieve the aforesaid burden on the County employees and desires to spread the cost of the employee portion of the monthly health insurance evenly per pay period throughout the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the County shall deduct the employee portion of the monthly health insurance premium equally per pay period throughout the year instead of deducting the entire portion of the monthly health insurance premium in a single paycheck.
2. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
