AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLARK COUNTY SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT NON-REVERTING FUND AND IMPLEMENTING PROCEDURES

ORDINANCE NO. 2005

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County is the County Executive pursuant to I. C. 36-2-2-2 and also functions as the County legislative body under I. C. 36-1-2-9(1);

WHEREAS, the Clark County Soil and Water Conservation District ("District") is an operational entity of Clark County government who may be entering into transactions and contracts with other political subdivisions on dates subsequent to enactment of this Ordinance. It is further likely and possible in the future that these contracts may result in payments made to the District;

WHEREAS, a need exists to create a Fund and a procedure by which monies paid to the District may be utilized for operational purposes of the District from time to time;

WHEREAS, certain monies paid to the District under the foregoing outline may be used to pay personnel expenses and, as such, it is necessary and proper that such expenses be appropriated by the Clark County Council, as fiscal body for the County, and that salaries be fixed and established by the Council, in those circumstances, according to law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

- 1. That each and every recital set forth hereinabove is adopted and made a term of this Ordinance;
- 2. There is hereby established the "Clark County Soil and Water Conservation District Non-reverting Fund" (the "Fund"). Said Fund shall be non-reverting in nature and shall hold all deposits and receipts of monies paid to the District, under the procedures and in the circumstances outlined herinabove;
- 3. That monies held in the Fund may be expended for operational expenses and personnel expenses of the District from time to time after such monies are appropriated for expenditure by the Clark County Council;
- 4. That, specifically, monies from the Fund may also be expended to pay employee compensation, for District employees, after the Clark County Council, as fiscal body of the County, fixes the compensation for each such employee and appropriates the requisite amount of compensation from said Fund for said personnel purposes;
