

REGULAR MEETING
CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

April 1st, 2021

The Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana met in Regular Session on April 1st 2021, at 5 p.m. in Room 418, Clark County Government Building, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

Present at the meeting were Commissioners – Jack Coffman, Bryan Glover, and Connie Sellers, County Attorney Scott Lewis, Clark County Engineer Brian Dixon, and Auditor Danny Yost.

Pledge of Allegiance and prayer was led by Jack Coffman.

Approval of the Minutes

Commissioner Sellers made a motion to approve the March 18th 2021, Regular Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the agenda with the amendments of a landfill discussion and a discussion about the time being changed for the next meeting. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Auditor Danny Yost presented the claims and payroll for April 7th 2021. Commissioner Glover motioned to approve the claims and payroll. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

I. Administrative Agenda

A. Attorney Scott Lewis presented opening bids for bridge 60 (Frank Fisher Rd). Each of the following were sealed at the time of opening:

Dave O'Mara INC, located at 1100 East O and M Ave. in North Vernon Indiana, placed a bid in the amount of \$735,812.45.

Louisville Paving, located at 15415 Shelbyville Rd in Louisville Kentucky, placed a bid in the amount of \$569,000.00.

E and B Paving, located at 1630 Broadway St. in Clarksville Indiana, placed a bid in the amount of \$679,791.75.

Commissioner Glover made a motion to take the bid under advisement and review by the County Engineer. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

B. Attorney Scott Lewis presented petition # 1-2021. Commissioner Glover made a motion to approve petition # 1-2021 in the matter of cancelation of taxes against real property owned by the town of Clarksville. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

C. Attorney Scott Lewis presented annual inspection of warning siren system in the amount of \$5,850. Commissioner Sellers made a motion to approve the annual inspection of warning siren system. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

D. Attorney Scott Lewis presented ordinance 6-2021 for the transfer of funds 6101 and 6201 to the rainy-day fund, and then the removal of the funds. Commissioner Glover made a motion to approve ordinance 6-2021. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

E. Matters Tabled from the prior meeting: None.

F. Sheriff Business: The current jail population is 433.

G. Auditor Report: Auditor Danny Yost commented that finding the two unused funds were a “good catch”.

H. County Attorney Scott Lewis presented an agreement with the operator of the landfill to pay 50% of the total cost of the barrier slurry wall project on the west side, not to exceed \$60,000.00. Commissioner Glover motioned to approve the agreement between the operator not to exceed \$60,000.00. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Attorney Scott Lewis presented the change of the meeting time of the May 13th meeting from 5:00pm to 1:00pm. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the time change. Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

I. Officeholder/Department Heads Present at Meeting: None.

J. Ratifications and Approvals:

Attorney Scott Lewis presented the offer of presenting a purchase of landfill property for soil usage. Commissioner Sellers motioned the offer, Commissioner Glover seconded. Motion carried 3-0

Attorney Scott Lewis presented a \$16,500 task order with United for Gravy Road. Commissioner Glover motioned to approve the task order. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion carried 3-0

K. Appointments: None.

L. Public Comments: Commissioner Sellers stated that a citizen had a concern about the county abolishing the mask mandate. Commissioner Sellers explained that they had no control over the subject and advised her to speak with a medical officer.

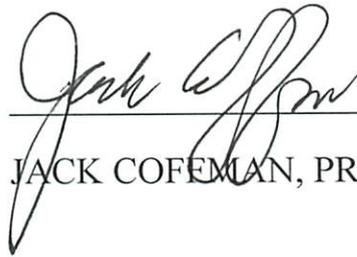
II. Technical Agenda:
