AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLARK COUNTY COMMUNITY TRANSITION PROGRAM FUND

ORDINANCE NO. 9 - 2006

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners ("Board") is the County Executive under I.C. 36-2-2-2 and, I.C. 36-1-2-9 the Board the Legislative body of the county authorized to enact Ordinances for the creation of local Funds;

WHEREAS, I.C. 11-12-10-3 provides for the local establishment of a Community Transition Program Fund in communities operating transition programs and the Clark County Community Supervision programs are the recipients of several grants, from state government, to support their operations;

WHEREAS, a need exists, in order to maintain compliance with state grant agreements, for the establishment of a Clark County Community Transition Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board as follows:

- (1) There is hereby established the "Clark County Community Transition Program Fund" as an official dedicated Fund of Clark County, Indiana, consistent with the provisions of I.C. 11-12-10-3;
- (2) The Clark County Community Corrections Advisory Board ("Advisory Board") shall manage and administer the fund, subject to the practices and requirements of the County Auditor's office;
- (3) Monies deposited in this Fund may be used to support and further community corrections programs, as determined by the said Advisory Board;
- (4) Monies from this Fund may only be expended after appropriation of same by the Clark County Council in the manner required by law;
- (5) All other recitals set forth hereinabove are incorporated into this Ordinance;

THIS ORDINANCE PASSED by unanimous vote of the Board on the ^{15th} day of June, 2006. This Ordinance made effective as of the 15th day of June, 2006.
