ORDINANCE NO. <u>38</u> -2012

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INCLUSION OF FEES FOR CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROVIDED BY THE CLARK COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISTRICT AS A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT LINE ITEM ON CLARK COUNTY TAX BILLS.

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-2-2-2, and also the the legislative body of such government pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, the members of this Board also serve as members of the Board of Directors of the Clark County Solid Waste Management District (the "District"), and as such are aware that the District adopted Resolution No. 2012-001 entitled *A Resolution Establishing a Special Assessment Line Item Fee for Curbside Recycling on the County Tax Bill* at its meeting on December 12, 2012 (the "District Resolution"); and,

WHEREAS, this Board now adopts this Ordinance for the purpose of authorizing the inclusion of fees for Curbside Recycling provided by the District to be included as a special assessment line item on Clark County tax bills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. This Board hereby authorizes the inclusion of all fees for Curbside Recycling provided by the District to property owners and/or residents of Clark County to be included as a special assessment line item on Clark County tax bills commencing with the Spring installment for 2012 taxes that are payable in 2013, and continuing thereafter.
- 2. All County offices involved in the preparation and mailing of property tax bills are requested to fully cooperate in the implementation of the billings authorized by this Ordinance, and the Clark County

Auditor is directed to distribute a copy of this Ordinance following its adoption to each affected County office holder.
