## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO THE RAINY DAY FUND

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-2;

**WHEREAS**, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-2-9;

**WHEREAS**, this Board has discovered unused and unencumbered funds for the current fiscal year;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to I.C. 36-1-8-5.1, this Board may, at any time during a fiscal year, transfer any unused and unencumbered funds to the rainy day fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

- TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$12,000.00) from fund #1138 Cum Cap shall be transferred to fund #1186 – Rainy Day Fund;
- 2. The total amount of the transfer is not more than ten percent (10%) of Clark County's total annual budget adopted under I.C. 6-1.1-17 for that fiscal year; and
- The transfer is not made from a debt service fund.
   So Ordained this 21th day of November, 2013.
