

RESOLUTION NO. 13-2008

AN RESOLUTION STATING COMMISSIONER POLICY
CONCERNING ANIMAL PROCESSING FACILITY

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners ("Board") is the County Executive pursuant to I.C. 36-2-2-2 and also functions as the legislative body of the County under I.C. 36-1-2-9;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners are authorized, among their general powers concerning public safety and among their other powers, to establish operating policy for Clark County and to take actions as will preserve and protect the general welfare, safety and public health in the County (I. C. 36-8-2-4) ; see also I. C. 36-8-2-8;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners are authorized under I. C. 36-8-2-10 to regulate the operations of businesses, crafts, projects and occupations in the County;


WHEREAS, among other functions of the Commissioners, they are authorized to engage in economic development in positive ways that will benefit the welfare, safety and serve the best interests of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That each and every recital set forth above is made a part of this Resolution, which shall hereafter be designated a statement of policy of the Board of Commissioners of Clark County;
2. The Commissioners hereby state and designate a policy of opposition for any proposed plans to place animal processing facilities, slaughter houses, animal packaging companies and any business ventures related thereto in unincorporated Clark County, Indiana.
