ORDINANCE NO. <u>23</u> -2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 9-1999 CONCERNING THE CLARK COUNTY AUDITOR'S ENDORSEMENT FUND AND AUDITOR'S ENDORSEMENT FEE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously adopted Ordinance No. 9-1999, which said Ordinance amended Ordinance No. 5-1995, which said Ordinances established the Clark County Auditor's Endorsement Fund and established the Auditor's Endorsement Fee for certain recorded instruments pursuant to I.C. 36-2-9-18.

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has amended I.C. 36-2-9-18, effective beginning July 1, 2019, whereby the legislative body of a county shall adopt an ordinance requiring the auditor to collect an endorsement fee for certain recorded instruments in the amount of ten dollars (\$10), which said amendment increases the auditor's endorsement fee from five dollars (\$5) to ten dollars (\$10).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Clark County Auditor's Endorsement Fee shall be increased to **ten dollars** (\$10) as required by the amended I.C. 36-2-9-18, which said fee shall be effective **July 1, 2019.**
- 2. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 9-1999 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning on July 1, 2019.
