ORDINANCE NO. 23 -2019

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 9-1999
CONCERNING THE CLARK COUNTY AUDITOR'S
ENDORSEMENT FUND AND AUDITOR'S ENDORSEMENT FEE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the "Board"), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Board previously adopted Ordinance No. 9-1999, which said Ordinance amended Ordinance No. 5-1995, which said Ordinances established the Clark County Auditor's Endorsement Fund and established the Auditor's Endorsement Fee for certain recorded instruments pursuant to I.C. 36-2-9-18.

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has amended I.C. 36-2-9-18, effective beginning July 1, 2019, whereby the legislative body of a county shall adopt an ordinance requiring the auditor to collect an endorsement fee for certain recorded instruments in the amount of ten dollars (\$10), which said amendment increases the auditor's endorsement fee from five dollars (\$5) to ten dollars (\$10).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Clark County Auditor's Endorsement Fee shall be increased to **ten dollars (\$10)** as required by the amended I.C. 36-2-9-18, which said fee shall be effective **July 1, 2019**.
2. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 9-1999 shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning on **July 1, 2019**.
