WHEREAS, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021, the Clark County Plan Commission passed PC Resolution 5-2021, (see the said Resolution 5-2021 attached hereto as Exhibit "A") to amend the fee schedule for planning and zoning as identified in the said Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. That the Clark County Plan Commission Resolution 5-2021, dated June 9, 2021, as attached hereto, is hereby approved, and the fee schedule for planning and zoning is hereby amended pursuant to the attached Resolution.
