ORDINANCE NO. 36 - ,2012AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE AMOUNT TO BE PAID TO PRECINCT BOARD WORKERS ON ELECTION DAYS. WHEREAS, IC 3-6-6-31 (b) allows for the legislative body (as defined in IC 36-1-2-9) to adopt an ordinance to provide meal allowances instead of meals provided under subsection (a). IC 3-6-6-31 further states that the legislative body must state the amount of the meal allowance to be provided. WHEREAS, the County Election Board (CEB) brought to the legislative body of Clark County the following recommendations: (A) That each precinct worker on Election Day be given the \$30.00 (thirty dollars) allowed for food as a part of their daily per diem. Therefore each person would be responsible to bring their own food for the day. (B)—Eliminate the food-allowance paid to election workers on Election Day. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF THE COUNTY THAT OPTION (A) AS RECOMMEDATED BY THE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD IS HEREBY ADOPTED.
